

**PROGRAMS OFFERED:** The Rock Academy offers two different programs for students, the Classroom Study Program and the Hybrid Program. Class is in session from 8:00 am to 1:30 pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Optional tutoring is on Monday and Wednesday mornings from 8:00 am to 11:30 am.

## 1ST-7TH GRADE: Classroom-Study Program

This program is available for all students entering 1st thru 7th grade. The Classroom-Study program mimics a traditional classroom setting and is led by experienced teachers. Curriculum, manipulatives, play, stations, and technology are utilized in the classroom for learning. Learning topics will be taught in class and these topics will be practiced with relevant homework on non-school days. This is a cooperative program between teacher and student. All homework needs to be turned in each class day. Regular attendance is imperative. Subjects covered: Math, ELA, Science, History, Daily Devotional.

## 8TH-12TH GRADE: Hybrid Program

This program is available for all students entering grades 8th-12th. Educational curriculum and time is split between online, teacher-led, and project based core subjects including: Math, ELA, Science, History, Foreign Language and electives. Students will also have interactive learning periods each day outside of their regular classes. The topics of study include, but not limited to: Government/ Civic Duty (i.e. Mock trial, Mock Election, Mock Legislature), Hands on Science (i.e. dissections, projects, building activities), Yearbook, Community Outreach, and Bible study/ devotional time. Tutoring is available to help with any problem areas and solidify skills being taught through our various curriculums.

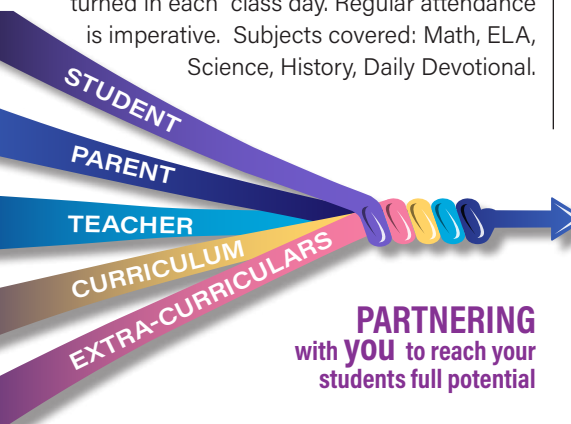
